

Article 1 Part constitution, amendments and changes

The present part forms integral part of the Contract which is part of the appendices of Sections A B C D1 and D2 of the Contract since applicable to the title of the Contract.

All the Contract stipulations apply mutatis mutandis to the present part.

In accordance with article 2 of the Contract, the Shipper commits himself becoming acquainted with any evolution or update of this posterior part at the date of signature of the Contract, notified by NaTran.

1.1 Amendments following legislative and regulatory changes of the legal framework

The stipulations of article "Amendments following legislative and regulatory changes" Section A of the Contract apply mutatis mutandis in the case of new legislative or regulatory provisions from any competent authority that may apply directly or indirectly to this part or a decision of the Energy Regulatory Commission under the article L 134-2 of the energy Code or a final decision of the CoRDIS under the articles L 134-19 to 24 of the energy Code, would come into effect after the Contract signature.

1.2 Other changes

The stipulations of article "Other changes" Section A of the Contract apply mutatis mutandis in the case of NaTran should amend the Contract for reasons other than those referred to in sub-clause 1.1 above.

Article 2 Object

This procedure establishes the practical arrangements for implementing interruptions on Day D in Daily Transmission Capacity on the Regional transmission and Delivery Systems defined as interruptible in Appendix 2 of this Contract.

Article 3 Information prior to Interruption

As soon as a potential risk of interruption is identified, NaTran shall endeavour to inform the Shipper by telephone or e-mail, if the said Shipper is affected by the risk zone.

Article 4 Notification of interruption for Day D (Interruption Notification)

4.1 Interruption Notification to Shippers

In order to preserve the balance of the network, NaTran can interrupt interruptible capacities - and consequently require the Consumer Delivery Point to adapt its consumption - with a minimum delay of 2

hours, without remuneration and without the Customer being able to invoke any prejudice whatsoever as a result.

NaTran shall send the Shipper a sole Interruption Notification to Shippers, specifying:

- the date and time of the start of the interruption,
- the Consumer Delivery Points affected,
- for each Delivery Point, the maximum daily and hourly quantities permitted from the date and time of the start of the interruption,
- the expected duration of the interruption.

NaTran undertakes to make its best efforts to inform the Shipper if the estimation of the duration of the interruption as indicated in the Interruption Notification to Shippers was to significatively evolve.

The lack of an acknowledgement of receipt does not release the Shipper from its obligation to restrict withdrawal by the Recipient(s) to the amounts specified in the Interruption Notification.

4.2 Consumer Delivery Point: Interruption Notification to Recipients

In order to preserve the balance of the network, NaTran may interrupt interruptible capacities - and consequently require the Consumer Delivery Point to adapt its consumption - with a minimum delay of 2 hours, without remuneration and without the Recipient being able to invoke any prejudice whatsoever as a result

for each Consumer Delivery Point mentioned in the Interruption Notification to Shippers, NaTran shall send the Recipient concerned an Interruption Notification to Recipients, specifying:

- the date and time of the start of the interruption,
- the maximum daily and hourly quantities permitted from the date and time of the start of the interruption,
- the expected duration of the interruption.

Article 5 End of interruption

NaTran shall notify the Shipper of the end of interruption by means of an End-of-Interruption Notification to Shippers.

The End-of-Interruption Notification to Shippers shall contain:

- the reference of the Interruption Notification to Shippers,
- the reference number of the most recent amendment to the Interruption Notification, if an amendment to the Interruption Notification has previously been sent,
- the Delivery Points concerned,
- the date and time of the end of the interruption.

From the date and time specified in the End-of-Interruption Notification, the maximum daily and hourly quantities permitted on the Delivery Points mentioned become the same as the Daily and Hourly Regional and Delivery Transmission Capacity specified in this Contract.

For each Consumer Delivery Point referred to in the End-of-Interruption Notification to Shippers, NaTran shall send the Recipient concerned a parallel End-of-Interruption Notification to Recipients specifying:

- the reference of the Interruption Notification to Recipients,
- the reference number of the most recent amendment to the Interruption Notification, if an amendment to the Interruption Notification has previously been sent,
- the date and time of the end of the interruption.
